

PLEASE READ ALL THE RULES

NOT KNOWING THE RULES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS AN EXCUSE FOR NOT FOLLOWING THEM. DISOBEYING ANY RULE(S) MAY RESULT IN YOU BEING BANNED FROM VISITING AN INMATE AND/OR CRIMINAL CHARGES BEING PURSUED WHEN APPLICABLE.

- Any violation is subject to suspension up to a permanent ban.
- All Inmates with scheduled visits will be screened for Active Protective Orders. Visiting an Inmate with an Active Protective Order is prohibited.
- All visits are subject to monitoring and recording.
- No electronic devices are allowed. (Cellphones, Smart Watches, Smart Glasses)
- Minor children (16 years of age or younger) may visit with an adult during the visit.
- All visitors 17 years of age or older must be registered and possess a valid government issued photo ID, such as a driver's license, state ID card, or military issued ID.
- Visitors may be subject to a criminal warrants and bond conditions check.
- Visits will last 20 minutes. Please be advised if an Inmate is in any program (at court, on trustee assignments, attorney visits, bible studies etc.), they are not eligible to receive the visit at that time.
- Any act of misconduct or violation of the rules and regulations of the facility will result in the removal of the authorized visitor and/or child from visiting area. A continued repetition of misconduct by an authorized visitor and/or minor child may result in the visitation privilege being removed with authority of the Jail Administrator.
